SUBJECT: Environmental Policy Statement

1. The intent of this memorandum is to ensure all members of the 186 Air Refueling Wing (186 ARW) to include civilian, military, and contractor employees working at Key Field ANGB are reminded of their responsibility in practicing appropriate environmental management techniques in the performance of their daily activities. The primary mission of the 186 ARW is to support the United States Air Force and the State of Mississippi by providing air refueling, air support operations, and expeditionary combat support during national and state emergencies, global contingency operations, peacekeeping initiatives, and training missions. It is imperative that we continue to conduct our mission with minimal negative impact to human health and the environment.
2. Key Field ANGB has an exemplary record of environmental stewardship which we will continue under my command. I need each of you to support our ongoing plans and programs including: spill prevention and response, storm water pollution prevention, hazardous waste management, community relation, affirmative procurement, and many other environmental programs.
3. Key Field ANGB has developed an Environmental Management System (EMS) of which this policy is one component. We are committed to using the tenets of pollution prevention (P2) to reduce our impacts to the environment. Through the use of our EMS, we will continually improve our environmental stewardship, and have set measurable objectives that will ensure compliance and mitigate environmental impacts. All employees have access to our EMS through the base internet ([www.msmeri.ang.af.mil](http://www.msmeri.ang.af.mil)). We have provided this policy and other pertinent environmental information concerning the 186 ARW through the Meridian Public Library and the Community Relation Plan.
4. Compliance with this Environmental Policy is the responsibility of every member of Key Field ANGB in accordance with his or her role and responsibilities in the organization. The 186 ARW is committed to full compliance with all applicable legal environmental requirements including federal, state, local, Department of Defense, Air Force, and Air National Guard directives and instructions.
