SUBJECT: Notice to Airmen (NOTAM) 20-008

- 1. May UTA update.** Members will be given options for May UTA based on squadron training needs. Both hands on and virtual training may be utilized. In addition, members will be allowed to reschedule drill if they desire. Each Group/Squadron will be sending direct guidance for May UTA.
- 2. Prioritizing cloth face coverings.** Cloth face covering are to be prioritized for use. Disposable procedural masks were provided for contingencies, but these masks are limited in supply and should not be used for daily wear. Members are expected to show up at the base with a cloth face covering. The wing is in the process of procuring cloth face coverings for every member of the wing and will distribute as supplies come in. - 3. Base and Building Screening Process:** All personnel entering the base will be screened for temperature at the front gate. Personnel entering any building on base are now required to stop at the main entrance and follow the self-screening process. Each member will sign in and sign out of the building. This guidance facilitate the tracing of personnel in case of possible COVID exposure.
- 4. Tricare Reserve Select and SGLI premium protections:** If a member has insufficient funds to cover Tricare premiums, coverage will not be terminated for a period of 90 days. Members are encouraged to continue paying their premiums as unpaid premiums will continue to accumulate each month. Member with SGLI will not lose coverage due to a month with no pay periods. Premiums for SGLI will be deducted at the next available military pay opportunity.
- 5. CACs expiring within 30 days:** Any member that has a CAC card expiring in the next 30 days should contact FSS customer service at 601-484-9303 to determine the best method for extending certificates and retaining access to government information systems.
- 6. Stop Movement Order Extended.** The DOD Stop Movement order has been extended until 30 June 2020. All domestic and international travel will cease until 30 June 2020 or until rescinded. Exceptions to policy will be reviewed and approved at the general officer level.
