SUBJECT: Notice to Airmen (NOTAM) 20-010

- 1. Emphasis on Face Coverings and Facility Screening:** Commanders and supervisors will continue to emphasize the wear of face coverings and the importance of conducting screenings at all facility entrances.
- 2. SEAP funds:** TAG has removed the cap on the State Education and Assistance Program (SEAP) funds due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The original cap of \$4500 has been lifted to allow college students an opportunity to request funds for summer classes. Additionally, the option to use SEAP funds for online courses is now authorized.
- 3. Mississippi FARM Corps opportunities:** The Mississippi Veterans Affairs office, Mississippi Farm Bureau, the MS NG, Mississippi Department of Agriculture, Mississippi State University Extension Service and MS Representative Trent Kelly have teamed together to find guardsmen and veterans employment. Job postings will be made available on the Mississippi Farm Corps website at <https://extension.msstate.edu/farmcorps/>
- 4. Workplace guidance:** JFH has defined local area for the purpose of personal leave, pass, and non-official travel as the boundaries of the state of Mississippi or 200 miles from duty location, whichever is less restrictive. Members that go on personal leave, pass, or non-official travel outside the defined area will adhere to workplace restrictions upon their return to work as outlined in the Supplemental to Mississippi National Guard Workplace Guidance During Coronavirus Disease 2019 Pandemic dtd 1 May 2020.
